



# **FOR ALL POLYURETHANE FOAM ROOFING SYSTEMS**

**The Building Official is requiring that the contractor retain the services of a Special Inspector (Architect/Engineer) to inspect all polyurethane foam recover systems as per Florida Building Code.**

**This inspector will be required to document that the work meets all requirements of the Florida Building Code and RAS 109 including but not limited to:**

- **Daily job log (RAS 109 6.1).**
- **Slit test results (RAS 109 10 and RAS 109 18).**
- **Daily test documentation (RAS 109 7.3).**
- **Product approvals (foam and coating).**
- **Site-specific engineering.**
- **Uplift/moisture tests as required, before and/or after roof application is completed.**
- **Final manufacturers certification (RAS 109 21).**

**Prior to the Building Department signing off the final inspection, the Special Inspector shall submit his/her inspection report to the Building Official, along with the approvals of the “In Progress” and the “Final Inspection”.**
