

Tamarac Transit Red & Yellow Routes Welcome Aboard

The City of Tamarac, in partnership with Broward County Transit (BCT), are providing this community bus transportation service to increase the number of destinations within the city's limits that can be reached through public transit.

This service is designed to work in conjunction with connection to BCT Routes 2, 11, 18, 55, 62, 88, 441 Breeze, the City of Lauderhill Route 4, Lauderdale Lakes North/South Route and North Lauderdale East Route community buses.

Fares

There is a 50¢ per trip fare that is collected each time you board, including when transferring from one route to another.

Drivers are permitted to collect exact fares only. No pennies, please. Drivers cannot make change, issue transfer coupons or accept BCT passes.

Bus Stops

Buses stop in front of business and clubhouse main entrances. Bus operators stop only when they see passengers waiting. Please stand in an area easily visible to the bus operators.

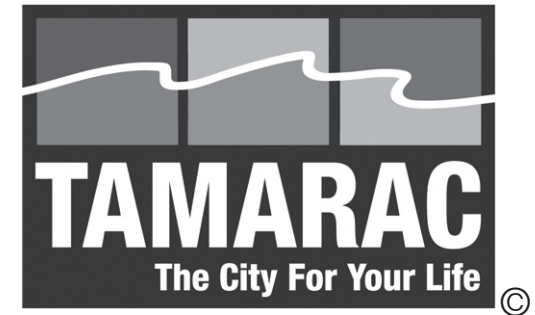
