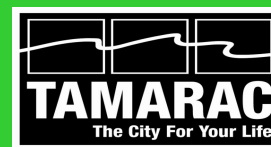

Little Shop of Horrors & Dinner @ Tides Grill (15) **Thursday, October 20 , 2011, LakeWorth Playhouse**

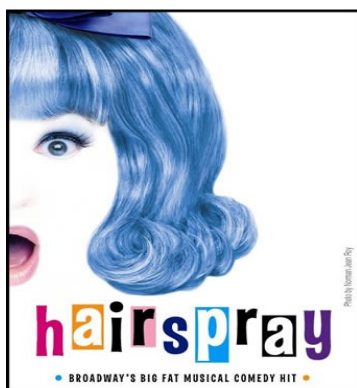
Bus leaves at 4:00pm and returns at 11:00pm.

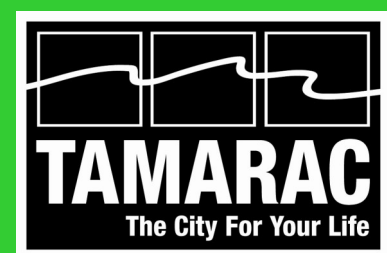
