

FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received the subgrant application for the City of Tamarac's City Hall Compound repair due to damages in Hurricane Irma (DR-4337-FL PW 05731). Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, final notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under the Public Assistance (PA) Program.

An initial disaster-wide Public Notice was published October 06, 2017 for Hurricane Irma. Comments and other information received were fully evaluated by FEMA along with evaluation of social, economic, environmental, and safety considerations. This notice serves as a project-specific final notice for FEMA's funding action located within the floodplain.

Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements.

- Proposed Work and Purpose:** The City of Tamarac repaired roof leak repairs, base cabinet, base board, parking lot light glass globe, chain link fence, roof coatings, light fixture cap, tar and gravel coatings at the City Hall Compound (Broward County Sheriff's Office, City Hall Building, Fire Station #41) as a result of Hurricane Irma.
- Project Alternatives:** The alternative that has been considered is the no action alternative. This alternative is not feasible as the area will remain vulnerable to flooding and water intrusion from wind driven rain. With the no action alternative, continued negative impacts will disrupt the continuity of operations affecting human health, safety and welfare.
