HURRICANE SEASON BEGINS JUNE 1ST

Special needs hurricane shelters are available through Broward County or Red Cross. Registration includes transportation to shelters in the event of a hurricane evacuation.

To qualify for services, pre - registration with the County's Elderly and Veterans Services Division is required.
