• **Minutes of 05/11/21** – Barbara Tarnove moved to approve the minutes as submitted, seconded by Carl Williams and Carl Apollon.

2. **Director's Report:**

a. Mr. Warner went over some of the actual happenings within the department such as:

- The Mother's Day Bake it on Wheels event on May 8th, was very successful.
- The Parks and Recreation Foundation of Tamarac Golf Tournament was sold out and made \$22,000 in profit
- The Ribbon Cutting Ceremony at Colony West Golf Club was held on May 25th and had 350 people attending the first weekend opened to the public.
- Sundaes on Saturday with Vice Mayor Villalobos on May 29th reports an attendance of 150 people.
- Memorial Day Ceremony at Veterans Park back in person was successful, 200 people attended.
- Caribbean Activities are scheduled as follows:
 - Caribbean Heritage Month Family Fun Day – Saturday, June 5th, 3pm – 6pm at Waters Edge Park
 - Caribbean Heritage Month Concert on the Green, June 11th, 6:30 pm – 8:30 pm at Colony West Golf Club

- The Tamarac Community Center will be opened starting today June 1st. The senior classes will be held with previous appointments and online as well.
- The Tamarac Recreation Center is preparing to open for Summer Camp on June 21st with 175 kids registered.
- The 4th of July celebration is not happening; it may occur on July 2nd as it was difficult for the companies to find the firework technicians available to work that day.

Mr. Warner updated the information to the members of the board as follows:
